



## BADMINTON

BWF (Badminton World Federation) rules apply with the following AISAA guidelines:

### Teams / Categories

To enter the team competition, schools must enter players into every category. Individual entries are also accepted if schools cannot field a full team.

A team consists of 8 players. 4 boys and 4 girls.

Boys Singles, Girls Singles, Boys Doubles, Girls Doubles, Mixed Doubles.

A player can only play in 1 category. No substitutions can be made during the tournament.

- Each player/ team will play the other schools one match. Table system (see below)
- Singles games are **one game to 21 points**. Doubles games will be played to **15 points**, best of **3 games**. *For G5-U all games, singles and doubles, one game is played to 15 points.*
- For players with 2 matches in a row, recovery will be 10 minutes.
- Coaches or qualified staff from each school will officiate other schools' matches.
- In the event that 2 or more single players in final table have the same points overall, then the placing will be decided in the following order:
  1. Head-to-head result between players
  2. Score difference
- In the event that 2 or more doubles teams have the same points overall, then the placing will be decided in the following order:
  1. Head-to-head result
  2. Games difference
  3. Least losses

### Table Scoring

1st – 30

2<sup>nd</sup> – 25

3<sup>rd</sup> – 20

4<sup>th</sup> – 15

5<sup>th</sup> – 10

6<sup>th</sup> – 5

Team trophy awarded for winning team (total points for all categories). If tied, then number of medals. If still tied, then mini-scores. If still tied, then co-champions.

Team trophies will be presented at the end of the tournaments along with medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for each category.
